The community's only Hospice for the terminally ill accepts patients at every age and stage of a life threatening illness. Programs include:

DAY WELLNESS

Provides patients support from the moment of diagnosis of a life-threatening illness. A variety of our weekly programs offer relaxation, stress and pain management, therapeutic benefits and more through activities like Tai Chi, Yoga, scrapbooking, painting and journaling, to name just a few. Individuals spend time with others sharing similar experiences while their caregivers get a much needed break.

RESIDENTIAL

Offers 6-beds providing around-the-clock care for individuals in their last 3 months of life. The private, spacious rooms feature specialized airflow mattresses, pull-out sofas for loved ones spending the night and ensuite bathroom facilities in a warm home-like atmosphere. Our families are encouraged to utilize all Hospice facilities as if it were home; even family pets are welcome!

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

A quick response team of medical professionals, including a palliative care physician, visiting terminal patients in their homes to aid with pain and symptom management while delivering services and support to families in crisis.

BEREAVEMENT

Provides many support services to assist people of all ages who are anticipating or grieving a loss by nurturing the body, mind and spirit. We also provide education and support to increase understanding of the grieving process, the needs of the dying and the bereaved by companionship individuals or groups in a caring environment.
